2024 Advent;

A Season of Hope and Anticipation

Dear Beloved Faith Church Family,

As we step into this sacred season of Advent, I want to encourage each of you to pause for a moment, breathe deeply, and truly embrace the miracle that is unfolding before us. Advent is a season of quiet anticipation, a time of waiting, and preparing our hearts for the arrival of our Savior, Jesus Christ. It's a moment when we remember how God's people longed for a Messiah, and how that longing was beautifully answered in the birth of a child in Bethlehem.

This Advent, let us turn our hearts to the Psalms, which are like a mirror reflecting our deepest hopes, fears, joys, and prayers. The Psalms capture the full range of human emotions, reminding us that waiting on the Lord is more than just passing time—it's an active expression of faith and trust in God's perfect timing and His loving plan.

The Gift of Waiting

Advent calls us to slow down in a world that seems to move faster every day. It invites us to resist the rush and to treasure the gift of waiting. **Psalm 27:14** encourages us, saying, "Wait for the Lord; be strong, and let your heart take courage; wait for the Lord!" This is a beautiful reminder that waiting on God is not wasted time. It's a time of growing, trusting, and drawing closer to Him.

As we wait for Christmas, we also look ahead with hope for Christ's second coming. Just as the people of Israel longed for the coming of their Savior, we wait with expectant hearts for the day when He will return in glory. Psalm 33:20-22 reminds us of this promise: "Our soul waits for the Lord; He is our help and our shield. For our heart is glad in Him, because we trust in His holy name."

Light in the Darkness

Advent is also a season of hope—a reminder that no matter how dark things may seem, Christ's light shines even brighter. Psalm 40:1-3 tells us, "I waited patiently for the Lord; He inclined to me and heard my cry. He drew me up from the pit of destruction, out of the miry bog, and set my feet upon a rock, making my steps secure." This is the hope we cling to: that God hears us, lifts us up, and gives us a firm foundation when we feel like we're sinking.



Each time we light the Advent candles, let it remind us that Jesus is the true Light of the World. His light chases away the darkness, filling our hearts with the warmth of His love and the promise of His presence. Whatever challenges you may face this season, know that His light is shining for you, guiding you, and bringing you peace.

Gratitude for Grace and Love

At the heart of Advent is the reminder of God's amazing love and grace. It's a celebration of the gift of His Son, Jesus, who came to bring us salvation. **Psalm 103:8-12** speaks powerfully of this truth: "The Lord is merciful and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love." What a gift it is to know that God's love is greater than our mistakes, that His grace is deeper than our sins, and that His mercy is new every morning.

This Advent, let us come before God with hearts full of gratitude for all that He has done for us. Let's celebrate His unfailing love and rejoice in the promise that nothing can separate us from the grace that came to us wrapped in swaddling clothes, lying in a manger.

Preparing Our Hearts for Jesus

As we draw closer to Christmas, let's take the time to prepare our hearts as well as our homes. **Psalm** 51:10 offers a perfect prayer for this season: "Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me." May we each ask God to cleanse us, renew us, and make us ready to receive the gift of His Son once more.

Advent is a journey that leads us to the manger, where the greatest gift was given—Jesus Christ, our Savior. As we meditate on the Psalms, let's open our hearts to be filled with the hope, peace, and joy that only Jesus can bring.

A Prayer for Advent

My prayer for each of you this Advent season is that you would know the deep peace of Christ in your hearts and homes. May the Psalms draw you closer to God's heart, reminding you of His love and faithfulness. May you find joy in the waiting, strength in the hope, and gratitude in the grace that has been so richly given to us through Jesus.

Let us journey through this Advent with expectant hearts, ready to celebrate not only the birth of Jesus, but also His presence in our lives today and His promise to come again.




Raise Right Fundraising Program


